Training on agricultural, crop dataestimation technique held in Pakyong

PAKYONG, DEC 1 /--/ In a significant step towards improving agricultural data collection and crop estimation techniques, the Agriculture Census Unit, KrishiBhawan, Tadong in coordination with the Agriculture Department of Pakyong, organized a comprehensive training session for the Agriculture Census Phase 2 & 3 and the Digital General Crop Estimation Survey (DGCES).

The training programme, aimed at enhancing the knowledge and skills of field personnel, was attended by all Additional Director of the Agriculture and Horticulture Department, Deputy Directors, Agricultural Development Officers (ADOs), Agricultural Instructors (AIs), Village Level Workers (VLWs), Field Assistants (FAs), supervisors, enumerators, and staff from the Agriculture Census Unit.

Tshering Chophel Bhutia, Additional Director of the Agriculture & Horticulture Department, in his address, highlighted the significance of the Agriculture Census in boosting the agricultural sector. The event commenced with a welcome address by Dr. Anjana Pradhan, ADO of the Agriculture Census Unit, who set the tone for the training. She emphasized the importance of accurate data collection in shaping policies for the future of agriculture in the region.

A detailed ppt presentation on the guidelines for Agriculture Census Phases 2 & 3 was presented by Rebecca Gurung, Deputy Director of the Agriculture



Department. In her presentation, she also provided an overview of the Digital General Crop Estimation Survey (DGCES), explaining its role in the modernized process of crop estimation. Dewas Sharma, KrishiSevak and staff of the Agriculture Census, then gave an in-depth presentation on the workings

of the DGCES, detailing the new digital approach to crop estimation and data collection. The training was concluded with a practical, hands-on session led by Anusha Subba and Dr. Sangay Bhutia, staff members of the Agriculture Census Unit. The session focused on the application

and use of digital tools designed for the census and crop estimation surveys. The Agriculture Census and DGCES are essential initiatives that aim to enhance the accuracy of agricultural data, providing valuable insights for future agricultural planning, development, and policy making in the region. New J'khand BJP president by February next year: Laxmikant Bajpai

RANCHI, DEC 1 /--/ BJP's Jharkhand in-charge Laxmikant Bajpai on Sunday said the party's new state president is likely to be selected by February next year. The announcement comes after the BJP suffered a defeat in the 81-member Jharkhand assembly elections. He said a membership drive of the BJP would begin in the state on December 7 or 8.

"Through this membership drive, we will reach out to every individual and create an all-encompassing organisation that will provide protection to all. And, there is every possibility that the new state president for Jharkhand BJP will be nominated by February next year," Bajpai told reporters after the party's two-day poll review meeting here. Babul Marandi is now serving as the Jharkhand BJP president.

Bajpai said that all feedback received during the two-day meeting was jotted down and the inputs would be kept in mind in the party's future plans for strengthening the organisation here. He said that parliamentarian D Purandeswari was appointed to see the membership drive in Jharkhand. "She will be in Jharkhand by Saturday or Sunday to guide how to carry out the membership drive," he said. The two-day meeting was held in five

sessions, and everything, right from election conduct to management results, was discussed, a party official said. The BJP contested 68 of the 81 assembly seats in the recently concluded Jharkhand polls but managed to win only 21. Jharkhand BJP working president Ravindra Rai said that they received positive responses for the party from across the state.

"The poll results were not in favour of the BJP. This was only due to misinformation spread by the JMM, the Congress and the RJD on caste and religion and against the saffron party," he said. He said that they didn't find any slackness on the part of the organisation or candidates in the two-day meeting. "Yes, there was some lacuna to take the issues to people. The party's vote share has increased in the state. We will emerge stronger in the coming days," Rai said. Irrespective of the poll results, the party will be working in the interest of the people and closely monitor the government whether it is fulfilling the promises made to people during elections, Rai said. Some party insiders claimed that "overconfidence, neglect of old workers, internal rifts and the JMM-led government's populist welfare scheme 'Maiyan Samman Yojana' were major factors" behind the BJP's poll debacle in the state. Himachal hasn't received disaster relief funds due to Centre's step-motherly treatment: CM

SHIMLA, DEC 1 /--/ The Union government has not given any funds for disaster relief since last year's monsoon, Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu said on Sunday, alleging "step-motherly treatment" towards opposition-ruled states.

Talking to the media persons on the sidelines of World AIDS Day programme here, he said accusing that the central government is

discriminatory towards states ruled by opposition parties.

"We had asked for a sum of Rs 10,000 under the PDNA (Post-Disaster Need Assessment) and should have at least got Rs 3,000-4,000 crore immediately on the lines of other states," he asserted. Floods and landslides during last year's monsoon was among the worst natural disasters in the state, leaving over 500

people dead and over 15,000 homeless.

"We have also not got the state's contribution of Rs 9,000 crore towards the National Pension Scheme (NPS)," Sukhu said. "This is the right of the state and I would meet the central leaders in the coming days and urge them again to keep the interest of the state in mind," he said. The Old Pension Scheme (OPS) was restored after the formation of Congress government in Himachal Pradesh and its leaders have been demanding the state's share in the NPS from the Centre. "Himachal Pradesh is a

small state and being a small state the voice of the elected MPs is not heard in the Parliament," he said. "I would raise the concerns of the state during the meeting of the Finance ministers scheduled in Jaisalmer in Rajasthan on December 20."

When asked about the controversy of a purported audio clip with "defamatory" remarks against Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, Sukhu parried the question saying he does not understand the matter and why it was being given any importance. Notice was

issued to a driver and conductor of a state roadways bus after an audio clip on Rahul Gandhi was allegedly played in their bus. However, the officials maintained that it was a fact-finding routine enquiry which was closed after the complaint was found baseless.

Presiding over the 37th World AIDS Day programme, the CM gave a "3G Formula" for prevention - "get aware, get tested and get victory over HIV" and urged the youth to contribute in raising awareness about it, a statement issued here said. (PTI)

Delhi's Air Quality Index drops to below 300 after a month

NEW DELHI, DEC 1 /--/ Delhi's Air Quality Index (AQI) dropped below 300 for the first time on Sunday after a month as dry northwesterly winds and ample sunlight aided in the dispersion of pollutants. The air quality in the national capital has oscillated between "very poor" (AQI between 301-400) and "severe" (over 400) categories for the past 32 days.

Delhi's 24-hour average Air Quality Index (AQI) was recorded at 285 at 4 PM on Sunday, an improvement to the "poor" category. The city's air quality was last recorded in the "poor" category on October 29, with an AQI of 268, according to data from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB). On Saturday, the AQI was 346 in the "very poor" category. The air quality slipped from "poor" to the "very poor" category on October 30 and stayed there for 15 consecutive days before deteriorating further into the "severe" category. On Sunday, out of 38 monitoring stations in the capital, 11 recorded air quality in the "very poor" category, while the remaining 27 recorded it in the "poor" category, according to the Sameer app. The CPCB classifies AQI between 0 and 50 as "good", between 51 and 100 as

"satisfactory", between 101 and 200 as "moderate", between 201 and 300 as "poor", between 301 and 400 as "very poor", and over 400 as "severe". The primary pollutant on Sunday was PM2.5, with levels recorded at 114 µg/m³ at 6 PM. These fine particles pose significant health risks as they can penetrate deep into the lungs and enter the bloodstream. Vehicular emissions, as reported by the Centre's Decision Support System (DSS) for Air Quality Management, are typically updated daily at noon. However, data for Saturday and Sunday was unavailable on the website until 4 PM, with the most recent estimate reflecting Friday's contribution, accounting for 21.6 per cent of Delhi's pollution. The Air Quality Early Warning System for Delhi observed that the predominant surface wind on Monday morning is likely to come from the northwest direction at speeds below 4 kmph. Smog and moderate fog are expected in the morning, with wind speeds increasing to less than 8 kmph in the afternoon, before decreasing again to below 4 kmph in the evening and night. Smog or shallow fog is likely to persist in the evening, with a clear sky during the day. Mahesh Palawat, vice president of

meteorology at Skymet, attributed the improvement in air quality to consistent dry northwesterly winds since Saturday, blowing at approximately 8 km/hr. (PTI)
